Keeping in line with our Phasing Back Plan for Day One policies, on June 1<sup>st</sup> the following will be implemented:

1. The children will begin to worship together as a school through Chapel in Kids Room. (Parent Chapels resume in the Fall with the new school year.)
2. Parents will drop off and pick up their children at the classroom.
3. With the announcement of Governor Abbot's Executive Order #36, masks are no longer required as of June 5th. For the safety of all the children, masks are recommended to be worn while in the classrooms.
4. Masks or facial coverings will be optional for fully vaccinated staff (generally considered 2 weeks after final injection).

As parents and families are re-entering the facility, I would like to take a moment to refresh some of our safety policies. The front entrance has a coded cipher lock for the protection of the children and each family is assigned a personal code. Please do not share your code with others or your children. Do not allow access to individuals that you do not recognize as a DOCA parent into the facility. Your assistance is appreciated for the protection of the children, families and staff.

Thank you to all the families that have supported our school this year. We are blessed and honored to partner with you as your children grow.
